

David Warther Museum is our last stop of the day where we will have dinner and see exquisite carvings of tall ships!

The National Packard Museum is "packed" with original and restored automobiles as well as numerous documents, photographs and artifacts detailing the history of this famous vehicle.

Historic Fallingwater. The epitome of "organic architecture" Fallingwater's design embraces nature and purposeful living accommodations.
