
Columbus Garden Railway Society 2024 Trip Thursday, Sept. 19 – Monday, Sept. 23, 2024

Historic Fallingwater. The epitome of "organic architecture" Fallingwater's design embraces nature and purposeful living accommodations.
Conceived in 1934 and completed in 1937 this home is a National Historical Landmark. The 1870 "bank barn" at Fallingwater is our venue for lunch.

We will then travel to the PA Trolley Museum and complete our 2024 trip! Founded in 1953, the PA Trolley Museum has preserved and restored a collection of 50 antique streetcars mainly through the efforts of volunteers! Many are in operation and used for daily rides as we will experience.
